

Core Commands

cd <path>	<i>Changes your working directory to <path></i>
ls	<i>Lists the files in the working directory</i>
ls <path>	<i>Lists the files in <path></i>
<command> --help	<i>Print help for <command></i>
man <command>	<i>Prints the help page for <command></i>

Files & Directories

cat <files>	<i>Print the contents of the <files></i>
cp <source> <destination>	<i>Copies files from <source> to <destination></i>
cp -r <source> <destination>	<i>Copies directories and their contents from <source> to <destination></i>
mkdir <directories>	<i>Create the <directories></i>
mv <source> <destination>	<i>Moves files or directories from <source> to <destination></i>
rm <files>	<i>Removes the <files></i>
rm -r <directories>	<i>Removes the <directories> and all of their contents</i>
touch <files>	<i>Creates the <files></i>
